The National Wildlife Federation WildlifeUnite Conference and 86<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting will be held June 7-11, 2022, completely online. The Natural Resources Council of Maine is our virtual 2022 co-host. Due to the ongoing pandemic and for the protection of all participants, the decision was made to meet virtually again this year. At the same time, we hope that the online format will make it easier for even more people to participate!

WildlifeUnite brings together leaders and activists who are working to protect fish and wildlife, habitat, and opportunities for people to enjoy the outdoors across the nation. The conference amplifies the leadership of our affiliates, gives voice to more leaders on more issues, and helps us build, broaden, and strengthen an authentic and diverse American conservation movement.
